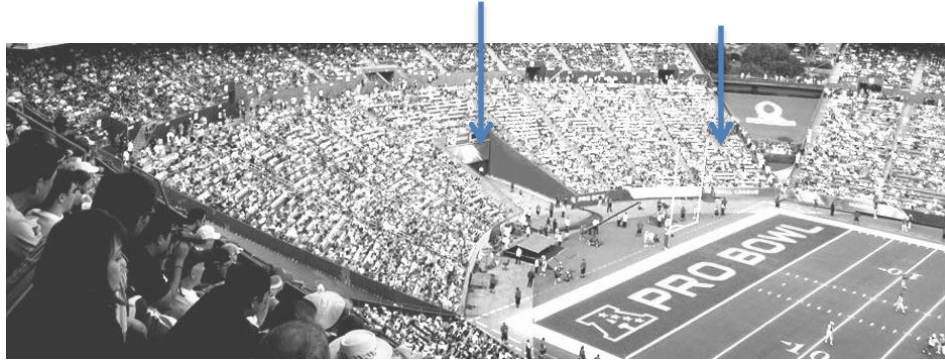

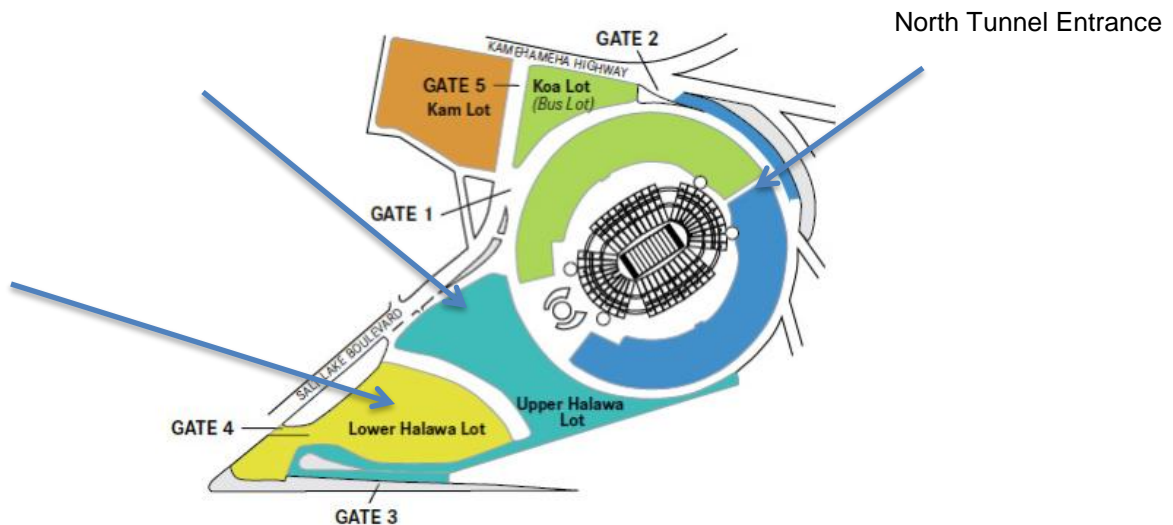
If you plan to **travel via school buses** to and from Aloha Stadium, here is pertinent information you will need:

- Buses will depart the UH Music Department at 1:00 PM
- Buses will return to the Music Department approximately 10:30 PM.

If you plan to **travel having provided your own transportation** to the music department **AND** to and from Aloha Stadium, here is pertinent information you will need:

- You will need to park in the Halawa Lot and proceed to the North Tunnel Ramp. One of our UH Band staff members will be stationed there to provide you a ticket for entry; security will need to check bags upon entrance.
