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## BAND CAMP INFO

### Attendance at band camp is required.

Band camp is a critical time to learn and establish marching and playing fundamentals. In addition, we must also learn our first half-time and pre-game show. The deeper and stronger marching and playing foundation we are able to establish during camp, the stronger we will be during the course of the season. Hence the requirement to attend camp and be prepared for focused and fast paced, yet fun week of rehearsals. This is the only time during the season when marching band will be your only priority! In order to be in the first halftime and pre-game show, you **MUST** attend all rehearsals. If, for any reason, you are unable to attend these rehearsals, please contact us immediately. ### SOME THINGS YOU'LL NEED FOR CAMP!

- Musical instrument – If you do not have your own instrument, one will be provided for you upon your arrival. (There is no rental charge for a university owned instrument.)
- Comfortable clothing for band camp week.
- Water jug! Drink a lot of WATER!
- Comfortable tennis shoes and socks. SANDALS, FLIP-FLOPS, AND/OR BARE FEET ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE FIELD!! Sunglasses, hat, sunscreen, etc. are also recommended for protection from the sun during the day rehearsals. Be prepared for a lot of sun and heat during camp! Ear plugs/hearing protection is also recommended, especially for louder sections.
- Once you arrive, we will need to know if you are on any type of medication or if you are allergic to any type of bee sting, etc. All of this information is kept confidential by the director/staff. BE HONEST for your own protection.

## IMPORTANT UNIFORM INFORMATION

Below you will find information about what you are provided and the items you will need to purchase or provide yourselves. Please read this section carefully. **ALL MEMBERS** should reference the enclosed order form and respond promptly. **\*\*Order forms are due in the Band Office by Friday, July 5, 2019.\*\***

### THINGS YOU ARE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE/PROVIDE

*All items can be purchased using the included apparel order form.*

- Black Shoes: All instrumentals must have solid black marching shoes and black gloves. ***If you have black marching shoes that are still in good condition from high school band, you may use those.*** If you need to order new shoes, please do so on the attached order form. **Black tennis shoes are NOT acceptable!**
- Black Gloves: All new members are required to order the gloves on the order form.
- Band T-shirt: The official member shirt **MUST** be worn at all game day rehearsals

and underneath the formal uniform. There will be times when we play in the stands without the uniform jacket. The shirt ensures that we all look uniform. **(RETURNING BAND MEMBERS: This is the same t-shirt as last year, however if your shirt has seen better days, please order a new one.)**

- Green UH Band Golf Shirt: All members will need to purchase a UH Bands green golf shirt for use at pep rallies, university events, and basketball/volleyball games.
- Flip Folder: Flip folders are required for all wind/percussionists at all rehearsals. **If you do not already own a flip folder, please order one on the attached form.**
